What?

The Numeracy Challenge is an annual borough-wide competition for primary schools, stretching those pupils who are nimble with numbers. In small teams of up to four, pupils complete 3 rounds of 30-minute challenging number activities over 3 weeks. Top-scoring teams will be invited to the Grand Final for a final brain-bending challenge on Friday 22nd May, where a winning team will be crowned.



Who?

The competition is targeted at pupils in Year 4-6, however it is open to all ages and abilities. Each school can enter multiple teams of a maximum of four pupils each, supported by a business volunteer or a school staff member. You may like to enlist pupils/volunteers that take part in any of our Partner Schemes or target other pupils in a maths club or similar, or just anyone you think would benefit! Please note that activities are designed to be scaffolded by adults. The same adult can work with multiple teams if necessary.

Round 3 – week commencing 30 March, 2020
